1756



Back in 1712 William Penn and Daniel Coxe acquired 9170 acres of land in Hunterdon County. In 1731 — 201 acres of this land was sold to William Johnson. Upon Johnson's death, Samuel Fleming was named one of the executors for the estate and purchased 105 acres of Johnson land. He built his home in 1756, which is still standing, on Bonnell St. and "Fleming's Town" came into being. Fleming's house, one of the most imposing in the area at that time, soon became known as "Fleming Castle." For many years it was an Inn and Stage Depot, frequented by many of the patriot leaders during the Revolutionary War.

In 1785 Flemington was chosen as the county seat in preference to Trenton, which at that time was part of Hunterdon County. When the old courthouse burned down in 1828, Lambertville laid claim to the county seat. This challenge was fought off and the courthouse standing today was built.

From its beginning, "Farming" was the lifeblood of Flemington and the county. The 1870's saw the beginning of modern dairy and poultry farms along with the coming of the railroads.

In 1898 fifty four trains a day entered and left Flemington on the three railroads that served the town (the last passenger train left Flemington for Jersey City in 1953). It was in 1965 that the Black River & Western R.R. commenced operating a full sized steam railroad between Flemington and Ringoes. In the same year work was begun on Turntable Junction in an effort to preserve an area rich in history.

GOVERNOR'S COMMAND 4.25
THE 6TH COLONY OF THE U.S. WAS NEW JERSEY. DURING THE REVOLUTIONARY PERIOD, ITS GOVERNOR WAS WILLIAM FRANKLIN, SON OF BENJAMIN. BECAUSE OF HIS LOYALIST CONVICTIONS, HE WAS ARRESTED IN JUNE OF 1776 AND AT THAT TIME THE STATE'S INDEPENDENCE WAS DECLARED. BUT WHILE WILLIAM LOST HIS POSITION AS GOVERNOR, HE RETAINED HIS REPUTATION AS A CONNOISSEUR OF GOOD FOOD. THIS HEARTY BEEF DISH, THE LIKES OF WHICH WOULD HAVE PLEASED HIS PALATE, IS PRESENTED HERE FROM AN ORIGINAL RECIPE. MADE WITH TENDERLOIN TIPS, COOKED IN A DELICATELY SEASONED SOUR CREAM SAUCE. SERVED OVER HOME-STYLE EGG NOODLES. WE HEARTILY RECOMMEND THIS.

CRAB SCAMPI 3.95
DELICATE PIECES OF QUEEN CRAB MEAT MIXED WITH A BLEND OF DOMESTIC AND WILD RICES. SERVED IN CASSEROLE WITH MELTED BUTTER AND FRESH CHOPPED GARLIC.

PATRIOT'S STEW 3.25
LIKE OUR FOREFATHERS WHO ENJOYED A HEARTY MEAL, YOU MAY LIKE OUR COUNTRY STEW. MADE WITH BEEF TENDERLOIN TIPS AND GARDEN VEGETABLES.

BUTTONS AND BOWS 3.50
AS THE 18th CENTURY MOVED INTO THE 19th, THE STYLES TURNED TO BUTTONS AND BOWS. OUR COOK'S STYLE IS CLEARLY SHOWN WITH MACARONI BOWS, SLICED TURKEY BREAST AND BUTTON MUSHROOMS BLENDED TOGETHER WITH A SPECIAL CHEESE SAUCE.

CAPTAIN SALTY'S CATCH 2.95
A COMBINATION OF FINE WHITE MEAT OF TUNA AND ELBOW MACARONI PREPARED WITH SAUTÉED ONIONS, PEPPERS AND PIMENTOS. BAKED IN A DELICATE CREAM SAUCE.

CHICKEN FLEMING 3.95
A FAVORITE DISH THAT COULD EASILY DELIGHT A TRAVELER STOPPING AT THE FLEMING TAVERN IN 1746. BONED BREAST OF CHICKEN SEASONED WITH CHIPPED BEEF AND BAKED WITH A MUSHROOM SAUCE IN CASSEROLE THAT WILL SATISFY A WEARY AND HUNGRY TRAVELER TODAY, AS WE ARE SURE IT WOULD HAVE DURING THE DAYS OF SAMUEL FLEMING.
